# Thank you to the Bill and Maryann Vinall Fund!



Recently, HSLWR received a notice from the Manatee Community Foundation that they had a donor who asked them to look for needs in animal welfare. The request could not have come at a better time! This year's "kitten season" has been extremely busy. We are so grateful to the Bill and Maryann Vinall Fund, whose grant of \$15,500 is already having a tremendous impact, and has allowed us to increase the number of cats and kittens saved.

One of those cats was Tiger Lily, a 2 yr old orange beauty (pictured above on the left). She was found as a stray with her 5 kittens and taken to a county animal shelter. HSLWR stepped in and the little family was transferred to our care. Unfortunately, Tiger Lily had a malformed back leg which made it difficult for her to walk. A veterinary orthopedic specialist recommended amputation to save Tiger Lily from future pain. Foster families cared for her and her kittens until each was ready for adoption.

Tiger Lily has healed, and has been adopted. As you can see by the photo on the right, she is living her best life with her loving new family. The kittens also have new forever families, making room for more cats to be saved.

Grants like that received from the Bill and Maryann Vinall Fund allow HSLWR to continue this important work. Our gratitude is boundless!


